



Announcement of Samrong Nuea Police Station

Subject: Anti-Bribery Policy

Fiscal Year B.E. 2569 (2026)

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In accordance with the Organic Act on Anti-Corruption, B.E. 2561 (2018), Section 128, paragraph one, which prohibits any state official from receiving assets or any other benefits that can be calculated as money from any person, except for those permitted by law, rules, or regulations, or those received in accordance with moral custom as defined by the NACC.

Additionally, per the Code of Ethics for Police Officers, B.E. 2564 (2021), Clause 2(2), which requires honesty, integrity, transparency, and accountability in performing duties, and Clause 2(4), which emphasizes prioritizing the public interest over personal gain. Furthermore, in alignment with the National Reform Plan on Anti-Corruption and Misconduct (Revised Edition), Reform Activity No. 4, to develop a transparent and corruption-free Thai bureaucracy, specifically Target 1, Item 1.1, requiring all state agencies to declare a "No Gift Policy."

Therefore, to prevent conflicts of interest and the acceptance of bribes, gifts, or any other benefits that may affect the performance of duties, Samrong Nuea Police Station hereby establishes the following Anti-Bribery and No Gift Policy:

Objectives

1. To prevent or reduce the opportunity for bribery and conflicts of interest among police officers at Samrong Nuea Police Station.
2. To encourage police officers to develop a conscience in refusing all kinds of gifts or rewards from the performance of duties.
3. To build an "Organization of Integrity" that is strong and sustainable.
4. To establish measures, guidelines, and mechanisms to prevent the giving/receiving of bribes or other benefits.
5. To regulate the acceptance of hospitality or gifts by executives and police officers at Samrong Nuea Police Station in compliance with relevant laws.
6. To support the National Strategy and the Integrity and Transparency Assessment (ITA) of government agencies.

Scope

This policy applies to all police officers under Samrong Nuea Police Station.

Definitions

"Bribe": Assets or other benefits given to a person to induce them to act or refrain from acting in their official capacity, regardless of whether such action is lawful or unlawful. This includes gifts, facilitation payments, tokens of appreciation, donations, hospitality, and similar benefits.

"Performance of Duty": Actions or duties performed by a state official in their appointed position or assigned tasks, as defined by law.

"Supervisor": Persons with the authority to command, supervise, monitor, and inspect police officers.

"Subordinate": All police officers under Samrong Nuea Police Station, excluding the supervisors.

Violation Measures / Penalties

1. Violations of this policy may lead to disciplinary action, criminal prosecution, or other relevant legal proceedings. Supervisors who ignore or neglect to address misconduct may also face disciplinary action, up to dismissal from service.
2. Lack of awareness of this policy or relevant laws cannot be used as an excuse for non-compliance.
3. Supervisors, as per Police Department Order No. 1212/2537, dated October 1, 1994, have the authority and duty to ensure their subordinates strictly adhere to this policy.

Monitoring and Oversight

1. The Superintendent of Samrong Nuea Police Station declares the intention to manage the agency with honesty, integrity, and transparency.
2. Supervisors are responsible for monitoring and inspecting their subordinates. If a violation is discovered, it must be reported to the Superintendent of Samrong Nuea Police Station immediately.
3. Samrong Nuea Police Station will periodically review and update these guidelines as necessary.
4. The Administrative Division of Samrong Nuea Police Station shall compile statistics on bribery and report any issues or obstacles to the Superintendent every quarter.

Protection Measures for Whistleblowers/Witnesses and Confidentiality

1. Complaints shall be handled with strict confidentiality in accordance with the Official Information Act, B.E. 2544 (2001). The identity of complainants and witnesses shall be protected to prevent unfair treatment or retaliation.
2. Upon receiving a complaint, the complainant and witnesses will not face any repercussions affecting their employment or livelihood. If necessary, protective measures (such as relocating workspaces) require the consent of the individuals involved.
3. Requests for protection from victims, complainants, or witnesses shall be considered by the responsible authority as appropriate.
4. The agency guarantees protection against harassment for those who file reports in good faith.
